The Challenge

All teams develop a bio-based innovation (product or process) and present their ideas to a jury of experts from academia and industry. The presentation must be accompanied by a few supporting documents explaining sustainability, technical feasibility, and economic viability of your innovation.

Who Can Apply?

The challenge is open for final year students of college/universities of applied sciences and all university students (BSc and MSc). Due to the multidisciplinary character of the challenge, it is recommended to embody multiple disciplines in your team, of which exact science should be one. Team members can come from different institutions

The Italian national competition is organized by Prof. Salvatore Fusco on behalf of University of Verona, Department of Biotechnology.
